Construction and future plans

New all abilities playground for Davis Park

LAHC is leading the design of a new all abilities playground at Davis Park, with community members recently joining LAHC to share their ideas for the new playground design.

Construction is anticipated to start in 2023, boosted by a \$200,000 grant received

from the NSW Department of Planning and Environment under its Everyone Can Play grant program.

Housing construction and sales

Construction works for Stage 3a and Stage 3b were completed earlier this year, with the next release of lots for sale scheduled for late July 2022.

New 'fit for purpose' social housing is also being delivered at Claymore to better meet future resident needs, with 27 homes under construction in Stage 3. 16 of these homes will be complete by June 2022. The design of new senior living units is also underway.


The Claymore Information Group is kept up to date about the progress of the construction program and addresses project issues at their monthly meetings.

Rehousing plan

Rehousing and demolition activities are being undertaken by the NSW Department of Communities and Justice. Rehousing in Stage 5 is now complete and Stage 11 residential relocations are 90% complete from Abrahams Way, Prestons Way and part of Gould Road. Approval to commence rehousing in the Stage 9a redevelopment area is expected to be received in mid 2022.
